IV. Matters Relating to this Notice

(1) The period of public notice shall run for seven (7) days, from 31 July 2026 to 6 August 2026, both dates inclusive.

(2) Any institution or individual wishing to raise an objection concerning the qualifications, academic background, veracity of credentials, or any other relevant matter pertaining to a proposed appointee may, during the period of public notice, submit such objection to the Editorial Office through the journal's official website, together with such supporting evidence as may be necessary. The Editorial Office shall give due and careful consideration to any objection so received, and shall take such further action as the outcome of its enquiries may warrant.

(3) Upon expiry of the period of public notice, and in the absence of any objection, or where an objection raised is found upon enquiry to be without merit, the appointments set out above shall

take effect accordingly, and the Editorial Office shall thereupon issue the relevant letters of appointment and publish notice thereof on the journal's official website. Throughout their respective terms of appointment, the Deputy Editors-in-Chief, Editorial Board Members, and Young Editorial Board Members shall discharge their duties conscientiously, and shall assist the journal in the review of manuscripts, the planning of topics, and the promotion of scholarship, so as jointly to uphold the academic reputation of the journal and to advance its academic quality and international standing.

The Editorial Office wishes to place on record its sincere gratitude to each of the above scholars for their longstanding support of, and confidence in, the journal, and looks forward to their continued and close collaboration in the advancement of academic exchange and scholarship within the relevant fields.
